

GIFTS

- Gifts are provided by God's grace and are given to members of the church to accomplish God's Will and to expand His Kingdom.
 - God provides various gifts to individuals in the local church. (Eph. 4:12; 2 Tim. 1:6)
- God has given each one of us talents, skills, and capabilities that can be transmuted into Gifts for His Glory and are empowered by the Holy Spirit.

 God provides the gaps for us to fill with our gifts and nurture them! (1 Tim. 4:14)
- The Bible warns us not to bury our gifts, but to use them and expand them. Find a need in the local church and fill it for your gift to blossom. (Matt. 25: 18-28)

OPPORTUNITIES

(John 9:4; Galatians 6:10)

 God provides UNLOCKED DOORS we must dare to open by coming out of our comfort zones, to seek and to find unknown opportunities. (e.g.: Joshua)

- Many a time, we are faced with OPEN DOORS of known opportunities through which we can see the possibilities of making a difference in our own world.
 - 90+ Top Answer: "I would have put my time, energy and resources into things that would make a difference in this world." (e.g.: Phil. 3:10-14)
- Often, there are no doors, but unlimited opportunities available to all when God provides OPEN SPACES that are free for everyone to explore. (e.g.: John 3:16)

DETERMINATION

- Gifts and Opportunities will remain idle and unused to deprive us and others of blessings, achievements, and progress without the dynamic of Determination. (Phil. 3:13-14; 4:13)
- Determination enables us to overcome our hesitations and trepidations and come out of our comfort zones to enable concrete, incremental achievements. (1 Cor. 14:12; Phil. 1:20)
- The Bible warns us repeatedly about lack of resolve in utilizing our gifts and opportunities through determination to zealously accomplish God's Will.

(Titus 2:14; 2 Cor. 11:23-27)
